Lessons

Mrs. B on the Keys is a music studio that provides individualized instruction for piano, vocal, brass, woodwind, and percussion students ages 4 and up. Each lesson involves an element of fundamental techniques of musicianship and theory. Individual, group, & virtual lessons are a great addition to enhancing students' minds. Lessons are scheduled during the Fall Semester (August-December), Spring Semester (January-May), & Summer Semester (June-July). Students should be on time for their assigned lessons with all required materials.

Tuition and Billing

Yearly Registration Fee = \$55 - The initial fee includes music theory and practice books. This fee is nonrefundable.

Monthly Tuition Payments \$125.00 (Individual Lessons) & \$115 (Group Lessons)

**Payments must be submitted via online invoice or in person by the 1st of each month to receive lessons. Any payment received after the 5th of each month will be considered late. Payments will not be accepted by mail. We accept cash and most major credit cards.

Please be advised that a \$25 late fee will be applied to the monthly invoice for payments received after the 5th of each month.

Missed Lessons

If a student misses a lesson, it will be rescheduled at the teacher's *discretion*. The studio is closed on scheduled holidays, and holidays are not rescheduled.

Practice

Without regular practice at home, the student will practice during their lessons, rather than refining and learning new skills. Practice is **not** about playing or singing through a piece once or twice. Effective practice consists of stopping to work on notes or rhythms that are frequently missed. Practice skills are taught in the lessons, and students should utilize these skills at home. Younger students need parental help in finding time to practice and knowing how to practice. As students mature, they should be able to take on the responsibility of practicing daily and correctly.

Suggested daily practice times (these times can be split into two shorter sessions each day):


4-8 years old: 15 minutes 9-11 years old: 25 minutes 12-15 years old: 35 minutes 16 and older: 45 minutes
